Scott Zeller, MD is Vice President for Acute Psychiatry at the multistate multispecialty physician group partnership Vituity. He is also assistant professor at University of California-Riverside School of Medicine. Dr. Zeller is Past President of the American Association for Emergency Psychiatry and known as the co-inventor of Emergency Telepsychiatry. He created the EmPATH (Emergency Psychiatry Assessment, Treatment and Healing) model for behavioral health emergency care.
